<u>Orientation Programme</u>: There will be a madatory Orientation Programme for all admitted students. All the students must be accompanied by a parent/guardian for the Orientation programme.

Date & Venue will be declared on the College website later.

NOTE on Reservation of Seats:

As per the Judgement dated 12th October 2017 of the Honorable Bombay High Court vide Writ Petition No. 1726 of 2001, Minority Colleges do not need to set aside seats for Backward Classes. This is reiterated by the University of Mumbai Circular (No. Aff./Recog.I/Admission (2018-19)/10/of 2018; dated 30th May, 2018; Point No.2).

Based on this notification, all the other notifications regarding Reservation of Seats during admissions are rendered null and void.

NOTE on minimum attendance requirements:

As per Ordinance of University of Mumbai 0.6086 dated 05/05/2014, 75% attendance at Lecturers/Practical is mandatory. Students joining this College are required to read and accept the provisions of the rules under Autonomy specially related to Attendance.

Students are expected to observe all the rules and regulations as regards discipline on campus. Students who have serious complaints of indiscipline against them during the year will not be re-admitted to the college in 2025-2026.
