(*Students of St. Xavier's College (Junior College), Mumbai)

Students who have passed H.S.C. from St. Xavier's College (Junior College) 5, Mahapalika Marg, Mumbai, and wish to apply for admissions to FY B.A./B.Sc. courses are required to fill in the online application form available on our College website's (www.xaviers.edu) "Home Page". The application processing charges of Rs. 500/- are payable online by debit card/credit card/UPI/Netbanking.

***Regular students of this College, who were studying in SYJC Arts and Science during the academic year 2024 - 2025** and have passed the H.S.C. Board Examination, are eligible for admission as in-house students **only in their respective streams** i.e. B.A./B.Sc.

Please Note:

- Only ONLINE application for admission to B.A./B.Sc. will be considered for the in-house quota.
- Though admission is ensured to in-house students, the allocation of choice of their subjects or course combinations is based on merit and availability of seats.
- Attendance at the Orientation Program is mandatory (date will be announced later).
- **In-house student who has any disciplinary issues against them during their Junior College at Xavier's, may not be considered for admission.**
