- Candidates can apply online by logging on to <a href="https://xaviers.ac/">https://xaviers.ac/</a>. Click on the link provided to fill the online Application Form.
- The will be open from 6:00 p.m. (IST) on 25th April 2025 online application portal to 6 pm (IST) on 25th May 2025.
- Online Application Form Fee: Rs. 500/-
- Candidates are required to make an online payment through the provided payment portal only.
- **NOTE:** Filling of the Application Form and the Payment for the entrance exam will be only through the online portal of the college.
- You will be sent a separate mail regarding details of your entrance exam.

### **❖ INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING ONLINE:**

- Log on to www.xaviers.edu (Between 25th April and 25th May, 2025).
- Follow instructions given on the website for filling the online Application Form.
  - The quota in which the candidate is applying for a seat, in case of minority/special quota, it is mandatory to uploada clear and legible scanned copy of proofe.g.,

    Baptism certificate for Catholic minority or document for special category as required
  - Semester V or V and VI marks must be entered. It is mandatory to upload a clear and legible scanned copy of the Semester V marksheet as proof.
- Once a payment has been officially received, the candidate will receive a confirmation email, informing him / her about the same.
- Please note that you must enter all the subjects and the corresponding marks in the online application form. Best of 4 or 5 subjects will not be accepted.
- Last date for receipt of Application Form is the 25th of May 2025 (6.00 pm).
   Any application received after this date will not be accepted.

- The fee payment step is in the middle of the application form, once the fees are paid you can continue to complete your form. You are encouraged to take a printout of the form once completed.
- If you want to resume form filling/edit details in your form post payment at a later date or on completion of the form edit certain details, click on the link given on the website and you can access your form either by your form no./mobile no. in either case you will receive an OTP and on entering the same you can proceed.
- Mumbai University graduates applying for this course are mandatorily required to enter the marks of Sem V (and Sem VI if available). No GPA will be entertained. If a Mumbai University applicant enters their GPA it will not be considered for the merit and no mail will be sent requesting for marks.
- If you have attempted your Semester VI exam in 2024 then on the page for marks entry click the check box indicating that your sem VI marks are pending.

# PLEASE NOTE WE ACCEPT ONLY MARKS ENTRY FOR EVERY SUBJECT FROM MUMBAI UNIVERSITY GRADUATE APPLICANTS.

### NOTE:

As per the Judgement dated 12 October 2017 of the Honourable Bombay High Court vide Writ Petition No. 1726 of 2001, Minority Colleges do not need to set aside seats for Backward Classes. This is reiterated by the University of Mumbai Circular (No. Aff./Recog.I/Admission (2018-19)/10/of 2018; dated 30 May 2018; Point No.2). Based on this notification, all the other notifications regarding Reservation of Seats during admissions are rendered null and void.

As per Ordinance of University of Mumbai 0.6086 dated 05/05/2014, 75% attendance at Lecturers/Practical's is mandatory. Students joining this College are required to read and accept the provisions of the rules under Autonomy especially related to Attendance.

Students are expected to observe all the rules and regulations as regards discipline on campus. Students who have serious complaints of indiscipline against them during the year will not be readmitted to the college in 2025-26.
